

15. PINOT NOIR | NEW ZEALAND

Delightful, fruity aromas of strawberry and redcurrant lead into tantalising savoury flavours of roast game, beetroot and raspberry. Soft tannins and a touch of acidity make it fresh on the palate.

16. RIOJA | SPAIN

17. WHITE ZINFANDEL | USA

1. PINOT GRIGIO | ITALY

A vibrant dry white wine with crisp citrus notes and flavours of fresh apple.

2. LIEBFRAUMILCH | GERMANY

4. GRENACHE BLANC | FRANCE
